

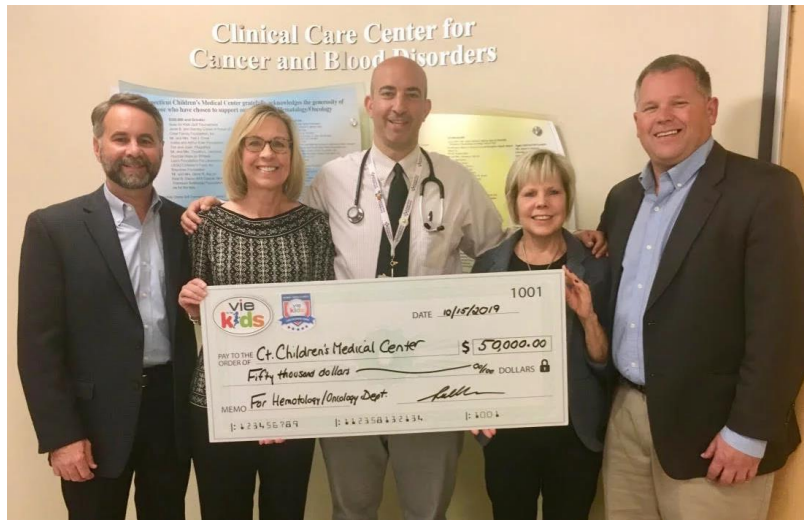


Vie for the Kids and The Robby Brisco Open Donate \$50,000 to Connecticut Children's
